

## PRE-OPERATIVE (BEFORE SURGERY) INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these indications:

- The first step is to confirm the date and time of surgery. Once the date is established preoperative evaluations and tests are performed:
  1. Laboratory tests
  2. Thorax radiography
  3. Pre-operative medical evaluation
  4. Other exams
- 48 hours in advance of the date of your surgery, you should go to the Clinic admission area, where the administrative admission will be made: remember to bring your Identity Card, endorsement letter (if applicable).
- Then you will be taken to the pre-admission area, for pre-anesthetic evaluation. You must bring all the preoperative exams.
- Once the admission is completed, you can go home. You must return the day of surgery as previously agreed time, fasting.
- If the procedure is outpatient must come accompanied by friend or relative at the time of surgery.
  
- To consider:
  - Medications needed in the postoperative period
  - Shave the surgical site
